POTATOES

Idaho MFC Norkotah stocks will be depleted by late June; the Washington storage crop will run through mid-July. MFC Burbanks will be shipped thereafter

CILANTRO

Production remains behind schedule; high demand has driven the market much higher. New plantings, spurred by warmer weather and longer days, will improve quality and yields over the next few weeks.

BRUSSELS SPROUTS

Prices are forecast to rise gradually as harvesting begins to transition north. The Mexican season is ending; supplies are nearly depleted. California's Oxnard and Santa Maria seasons are underway; Salinas Valley supplies will come online in early to mid-July.



SQUASH

- Markets continue to ease as more East Coast growing regions begin harvests.
- · Production is underway in California and Mexico as well.

BROCCOLI

- Prices are elevated and expected to continue rising.
- California supplies are struggling to meet increased demand; total planted acreage is down and cooler, windy weather has lowered vields.

LEMONS

- The 165- through 235-count lemon market remains elevated due to extremely low volume and strong demand.
- Offshore and Mexican lemons will help supplement domestic supplies through December.

Markon has gathered a group of our member- and grower-affiliated chefs to answer your questions about produce.

Summer means ripe, juicy tomatoes. As the season gets underway, how do you suggest showcasing these wellloved ingredients across the menu?



I'm a huge fan of marinating raw tomatoes in white balsamic, olive oil, fresh thyme, black pepper, and salt.



It will not only help preserve the tomatoes, but the flavor combination goes a long way in bringing out both sweet and savory notes.



When left to marinate over night, these tomatoes are the perfect way to serve as bruschetta. caprese salad, or fresh grilled fish entrée.









TIPS FOR SERVING GREEN LEAF LETTUCE



- Use MFC Premium Green Leaf Lettuce to top tacos, tostadas, burgers, and sandwiches.
- Accent lettuce color with toppings such as crumbled goat cheese, roasted beets, and toasted pepitas or give balance by Lussing willing ingredients like blueberries, kiwifruit, and pea pepitas or give balance by tossing with light, sweet
- Mix together bulgur wheat, chopped MFC Tomatoes, RSS Washed & Trimmed Green Onions. RSS Lemon Juice, roasted RSS Peeled Garlic. RSS Washed & Trimmed Parsley, MFC Mint, and chopped MFC Premium Green Leaf Lettuce; serve tabbouleh with warm pita triangles.

MFC Artisan Romaine Vietnamese Shrimp Wraps with Chili Crisp

Grilled shrimp, pickled vegetables, and aromatic rice result in a craveable, year-round appetizer or entrée.

2 C rice, rinsed 1 C coconut milk 2 C water 2 Toil 12 extra-large shrimp, peeled 1 tsp. kosher salt ½ tsp. black pepper 8 heads MFC Artisan Romaine Lettuce, split in half lengthwise 32 MFC Cherry Tomatoes 1/2 C MFC Mint 1 C MFC Cilantro, split

1 C MFC Cucumbers, sliced and quick pickled 2 each MFC Red and Green Jalapeno Chile Peppers

Combine rice, coconut milk, water, and ½ cup finely chopped cilantro in a rice cooker. Heat until done. Season shrimp with salt and pepper. Heat oil on flat top or grill pan. Char shrimp, romaine, and cherry tomatoes until grill marks appear. Arrange romaine with equal parts rice, shrimp, tomatoes, herbs, cucumbers, and chiles. Serve immediately.
