



FRESH CROP REPORT WEEK OF JANUARY 19, 2025







HIGHLIGHTS

AZ-CA DESERT REGION

The Arizona-California desert growing region continues to experience the coldest week of the winter growing season; widespread moderate-to-heavy lettuce ice is delaying harvests and loading.

CILANTRO

Markets are steady at low levels; supplies remain available across several growing regions but will diminish as January progresses. Strong winds are causing elevated levels of damaged leaves, tip burn, and early breakdown.

STRAWBERRIES

Although prices are holding fairly steady, cold weather is impeding berry maturation in all growing regions.



LEMONS

- Expect steady markets and ample supplies through February.
- Seedless lemons are also on the market.

AVOCADOS

- The industry remains in a demand-exceeds-supply situation.
- Expect extremely low volume and higher prices for the next two weeks.

BROCCOLI

- Markets are weak and supplies are ample, but low temperatures and overnight frosts are hindering crown maturity.
- Strong winds are dehydrating plants and slowing growth.
