# HIGHLIGHTS

# SOUTHERN WINTER STORM ENZO

Produce logistics are hampered across the southern U.S. due to snow and icy weather. Seaport and airport closures are occurring; freeways are slow/closed due to historical snowfall totals restricting the flow of produce commodities.

## **BROCCOLI**

Prices are steady at moderate-to-lower levels but are poised to rise following persistently cool weather in the Arizona-California desert region. Mexican-grown MFC Broccoli is available in South Texas; quality is very good amid mostly temperate and dry conditions.

## AZ-CA DESERT COLD SNAP CONTINUES

Apart from stalled growth, the combination of strong winds followed by freezing temperatures will have lasting effects on case weights, quality, and shelf-life performance of lettuce and tender leaf items.



## **GRAPES**

- Offshore shipments are arriving in U.S. ports; the California season has ended.
- Expect increased supplies and slowly declining markets through February.

# GREEN LEAF, ICEBERG, & ROMAINE

- Strong winds and low temperatures persist in the Arizona/ California desert growing regions.
